# Georgia Long Term Care Infectious Disease Educational Program

The University of Georgia's Institute for Disaster Management in conjunction with local, state, and federal partners is pleased to announce the award of a three-year Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS) Civil Monetary Penalty (CMP) funded grant, the Georgia Long Term Care Infectious Disease Educational Program (GA LTCIDEP).

The GA LTCIDEP is for certified long term care facility staff and is targeting infection preventionists, other clinical care providers, and non-clinical staff to develop knowledge, skills, and abilities related to infectious diseases. Topics covered include infectious disease precautions, prevention, protection, and disinfection. The concepts introduced in each course can be used to improve the health and safety of residents and staff members.

There will be two educational courses offered throughout the program. In Year 1, 14 Foundations Courses were offered. Year 2 courses are now open for registration! See below for more details.

- Year 2: Infectious Disease Principles Course, 1 offered in each healthcare coalition (14 total)
- Year 3: Seven offerings of each course, 1 course offering per healthcare coalition (14 total)
